MASTERS Candidates

Recommendations and Expectations:

- Complete the program in 3 years (preferably less)
- Maintain an acceptable GPA (3.0 or better, B- or better in all required courses)
- Complete a recommended minimum of 12 credit hours each year
- Must complete 6 credit hours/year or automatically dropped (university policy)
- Recommend students **not** register for more than 12 credit hours in a semester or 6 credit hours in a term (recommended maximum of 33 credit hrs/year)
- Two (2) marginal or unsatisfactory ratings (back to back) will result in student being dropped from the program.

- Must complete 6 credit hours/year or automatically dropped (university policy)
- Recommend students **not** register for more than 12 credit hours in a semester or 6 credit hours in a term (recommended maximum of 33 credit hrs/year)
- Two (2) marginal or unsatisfactory ratings (back to back) will result in student being dropped from the program.
